RESOLUTION FOR REQUIREMENT OF DEPOSIT FOR FIRE HYDRANT METER
AND BACKFLOW PROTECTION EQUIPMENT RENTAL BY
GLENWOOD MUNICIPAL UTILITIES, BOARD OF TRUSTEES
BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GLENWOOD MUNICIPAL UTILITIES BOARD OF TRUSTEES
OF GLENWOOD, IOWA AMENDING RESOLUTION 701-23

The following is a requirement for a deposit on rental of fire hydrant meters, installation assembly and backflow protection equipment used within the GMU distribution system:

- A \$4000.00 deposit will be required and retained during rental usage period, for each of GMU's fire hydrant meters and appurtenances until all are returned in good condition. Upon return, the deposit will be applied to bulk water billing with remainder refunded. Should the metering assembly equipment be lost or stolen, the deposit will be applied toward replacement of like equipment with any additional costs billed to the customer.
- Any fire hydrant meter renter shall pay all water charges, rental fees, and processing/testing fee.
- Monthly water charges are billed at the current bulk water rate.
- Rental fees for hydrant metering equipment is \$2.00 per day or a yearly non-refundable rental fee of \$730.00 paid at pickup and due each anniversary, along with annual equipment testing or equipment exchange.
- A Fire Hydrant metering equipment license agreement / contract will be required with each rental of hydrant metering assembly.
- Fire Hydrant metering assemblies will be allowed at pre-approved sites only.

This resolution revises any previous or conflicting fire hydrant metering assembly deposits, water charges for hydrant metering and equipment rental charges set.
